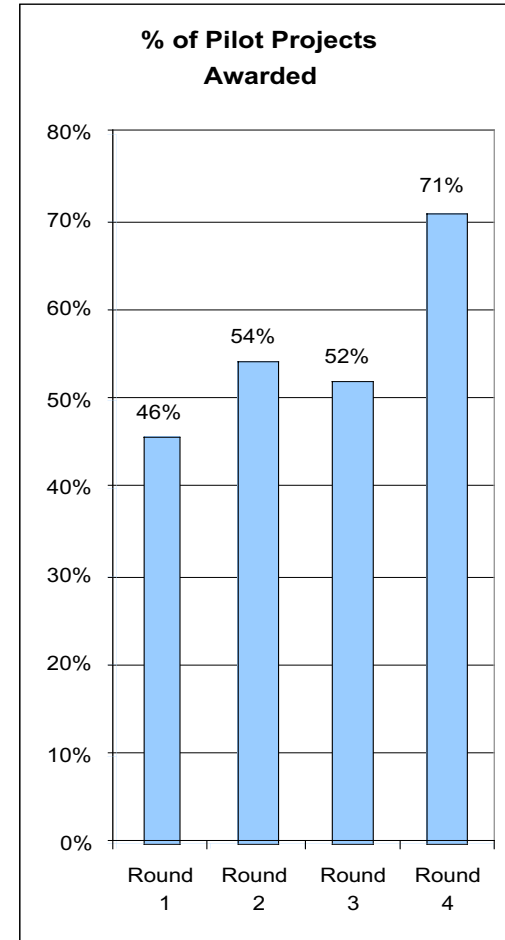
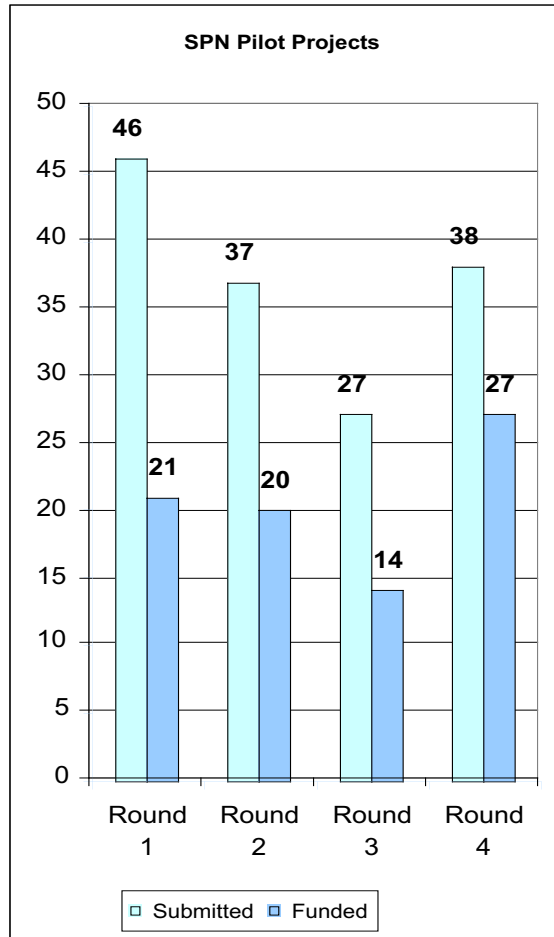
- More than 2,000 community people trained in cancer control, undergoing curricula developed by the SPNs

SPN Pilot Projects:

148 Pilot project applications submitted in 4 Rounds representing about 120 first time minority/underserved investigators

82 Awarded after peer review

- 179 Pilot applications submitted in 5 rounds, representing more than 140 minority scientists in 3 years

- More than 90 papers submitted/published since beginning of this SPN program

- Funding obtained outside of SPN funding:
- At least 11.5 million dollars from 4/2000-1/2003
