## **Partnership Institutions**



## Temple University-Fox Chase Temple Health

- Located in Philadelphia
- >51% of students from diverse communities
- 70% receive need-based aid

#### **Hunter College**

- Located in NYC
- US DOE designated Minority-Serving Institution
- 72% of students from diverse communities
- 74% receive need-based aid











## Summer Cancer Research Institute (SCRI)

- 8-week intensive mentored research training program for undergrads
- Held in Philadelphia (labs at TUFCCC)
- Curriculum: Didactic lectures, "How-to" workshops, a lab techniques mini course

- Exposure to different career opportunities
  - Genetic counselors
  - Registered dieticians
  - Social work
  - Clinical staff
- Skill-building workshops
- Research symposium















# **SCRI Accomplishments**



- 6 SCRI grads enrolled in medical school
- 4 SCRI grads enrolled in graduate school
- 9 SCRI grads have co-authored peer-reviewed papers
- 2022 SCRI
  - 2 HC trainees returned to work with their TUFCCC mentor in 2023 (paid for by mentor's grant, <u>not</u> U54)
- 2023 SCRI
  - 5 grads will continue work with their TUFCCC mentor in Fall 2023
  - HC trainees matched with HC mentors & labs










## Mentorship for Advanced Trainees

- Annual Pilot Grants supported by institutional commitment from TUFCCC
- Monthly meetings & webinars
- Research output
  - 80 publications
  - 298 conference presentations
- Total: 207 trainees
  - SCRI, Pilot awardees, ESIs involved in U54
  - >75% had educ/career advancement
    - 58 (28%) awarded post-grad degree
    - 99 (47%) enrolled in post-grad program, obtained faculty/postdoc position


